Directions to St Brides Village Hall

The Welsh Springer Spaniel Club of South Wales will be using St Brides Wentlooge Village Hall, NP10 8SH, for the **Trimming and Grooming Workshop** on Sunday 6th October 2019.

This is a new venue for the Club, it is easily accessible from the M4 Junction 28, you might know it as Tredegar House roundabout. Following are directions for the simplest route from Junction 28 of the M4.

There is another route from the Newport side to Lighthouse Road, which you may know if you are local to the area, but I have used the following route as it is more efficiently signposted.

From Bassaleg and Risca A467

Approaching the Junction keep in the middle lane to go right, taking the A48 (W) to Castleton,

then keeping in left lane, turn left into Pencarn Way - signposted Dyffryn,/Imperial Park/Asda Superstore – follow this road, straight across first roundabout, straight across the next roundabout (ASDA's), carry on along DyffrynWay a short way, turn right after the Pedestrian crossing traffic lights into Morgan Way. Follow this road to the end, at the T Junction turn right on to the B4239, Lighthouse Road, over the Railway line, follow this for a mile or so, with open farmland, alongside the drainage ditches. This section of the road has series of sharp bends, leading to a left hand turning onto Beach Road, turn into Beach Road and immediately look for the entrance to the hall carpark. The Hall is the building right in front of you on the corner

From the west (Bridgend, Cardiff etc.) via M4

Exit at Junction 28, on slip road keep in the right hand lane follow signs for the A48(W) to Castleton,

then keeping in left lane, turn left into Pencarn Way - signposted Dyffryn,/Imperial Park/Asda Superstore, rest as above.

From the east (Chepstow, Newportetc.) via M4

Exit at Junction 28, on slip road keep in the middle lane follow signs for the A48(W) to Castleton,

then keeping in left lane, turn left into Pencarn Way - signposted Dyffryn,/Imperial Park/Asda Superstore, rest as above.
